

FEDERAL PROGRAM – DOMESTIC INTERNATIONALLY TRAINED WORKERS POOL (DITWP)

Domestic Internationally Trained Workers Pool (DITWP): A resource for employers to tap into a pool of internationally trained workers already in Canada. This pool includes:

- Ukrainian Displaced Persons
- Immigrants and Resettled Refugees
- Other Open Work Permit Holders
- Refugee Claimants and Their Family Members
- International Students with Post-Graduation Work Permits

Key Features:

- **No LMIA Required:** Employers do not need to apply for a Labour Market Impact Assessment (LMIA) to hire from this pool.
- **Immediate Work Authorization**: Workers in this pool are entitled to work for any employer immediately upon arrival or approval of their status.
- **Wide Range of Occupations**: Positions in any level of occupation are eligible, making it suitable for various sectors, including tourism and hospitality.

How to Use the DITWP:

- Register on Job Bank: Employers can register or sign into the Job Bank and create a new job posting.
- Advertise Job Postings: Share the new job posting through regular recruitment channels and contact local immigrant settlement agencies for additional support.
- Engage with Immigrant Employment Councils: Seek resources and support from the National Network of Immigrant Employment Councils to connect with potential candidate
